About GDPR

More than 95% of all mobile apps share personal data such as GPS-location, IP address, online- and cookie identifiers. Simultaneously, mobile apps continuously share information about visitors' usage of the app with third-party data processors.

You must comply with the GDPR if your mobile app collects and processes personal data that is transferred to your company or to third-party data processors. To be compliant, you are required to provide documentation for each visitor's consent to the processing of their personal data, and proof that your website respects cookie opt-outs.

Mobile App GDPR Compliance Audit

Our GDPR Compliance Audit assesses whether your mobile app adheres to the GDPR Cookie/ePrivacy directive, and whether it poses data privacy- and security risks for your company. The audit provides you with specific recommendations that enable you to record and solve compliance issues.

GDPR Compliance checklist

1. Get an overview and record of your app's data collection and data processing

You must know which personal data your app collects or transfers from the user's mobile device. Our Mobile App Audit provides you with documentation about your data collection and processing.

2. Inform the app users of the data collection and data processing

Your company's privacy policy must be available to the app's users and must provide information about what personal data is collected, why they are collected, and who processes these data.

3. Inform the app's users about data transfer to third-party data processors

You must inform app users about third-party data processors receiving personal data from your mobile app, and why they process the users' personal data. Our audit of your company's app provides valuable recommendations about this.

4. Collect users' consents

You must collect the users' consents. The content of the consent agreement with the app users must be adequate before you are legally allowed to process their personal data.

5. Be available for the app's users

The users of your mobile app must be able to easily contact your company to gain access to the personal data that your company stores.

6. Apply proper personal data security measures

You must implement suitable technical security measures to protect the personal data processed by your mobile app. Our audit examines the security level of the personal data on your company's app.
